INFORMATION ON BASIC MACHINE CLASS Held at TEXMAC Inc. / Charlotte, NC Location

Schedule: Classes will run 9:30am-12:00pm and resume in the afternoon from 1:30pm-5:00pm

Note: We will adjust the topic schedule and order based on demand. Topics covered may include some or all of those shown below:

- **Morning Session Topics (9:30 to 12:00)**
 - Embroidery Machines Intro/ (needles, thread, machine basics)
 - Introduction to Control Panel: Basic Operations, Setting design colors and hoop fit
 - Basic Threading and Tension
 - Hooping basics
 - Techniques for different garments: backing, topping, needles, etc.
 - In-class practice: setting tension, threading, hooping, control panel basics, design run-through
- **Afternoon Session Topics (1:30 to 5:00pm)**
 - More on embroidery settings/adjustments
 - Sewing on finished ballcaps
 - Basic Upkeep/Maintenance: Oiling and Cleaning
 - In-class practice: hooping ballcaps, cap driver installation/setup
- **Additional/Optional Topics (based on class requests / available time, etc)**
 - Practical troubleshooting, common maintenance / machine adjustments
 - Firmware & other machine updates
 - Embroidery Business: pricing/costing, production basics, sourcing, marketing
 - Additional hooping techniques / devices (Hoopmaster / clamps / gator clamps / alternate hoops)

Recommended pre-learning preparation: Upon receiving your registration, your instructor will provide a link to some recommended material to preview before class, including some orientation videos, checklists, etc. Advance review of this material will help you get more out of the class, allowing more hands-on practice.

Procedures and Policies for Training Classes at TEXMAC Inc.

- Up to 2 persons per company may attend. Attendees must be at least 16 years of age, due to the operation of machinery in the classroom
